We finally made it to our final required adventure for the Wolf rank of Cub Scouts: Call of the Wild!

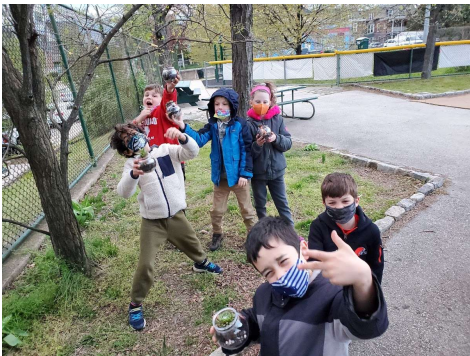
This adventure focuses on camping skills and the great outdoors. The Wolves will be participating in a day camp at the Scout House in Wissahickon Valley Park. They will be introduced to camping skills such as selecting and bringing gear, setting up and tearing down a tent, and being prepared for bad weather. Wolves will also learn about animals they might see, the Leave No Trace Principles for Kids, tying knots, and how to handle potentially harmful situations.

Our biweekly meetings will continue to take place at Mt. Airy Playground. In the event of rain, our meetings will take place on the following day (Thursday) at the same time and place or the following week. I will send out a cancellation email the morning of in the event of rain with the makeup day. During our in-person meetings, we will continue to observe best and safe practices. All participants and parents will be required to wear masks regardless of their vaccination status, and all individuals must complete the [COVID-19 Gating Questionnaire](#) prior to attendance.

The Scout House is located on Wigard Ave. just off of Henry Ave. in Roxborough. Its location is perfect for hiking the Wissahickon, building a campfire, and playing some camp games. 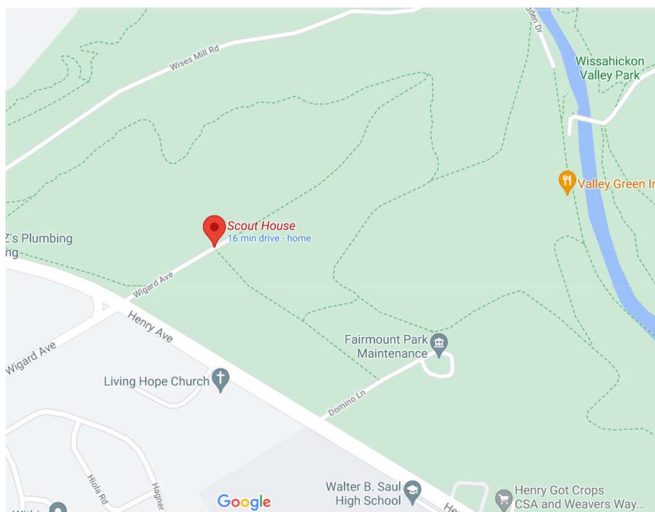
