Home-based Lesson: Celebrating Catholic Identity ~ Sacrament of Baptism (R 9 - 16)

Please complete lesson and return completed work to class for next onsite lesson at OMC.

- Read R-9 (follows pg. 128). Read the page and complete the activity. If needed, offer examples like swimming in a pool, fishing, playing by the ocean. Read aloud the last paragraph. Tell your child some stories about the day of their baptism. If you have pictures, show them the pictures as you tell the stories.

- Use the prayer on R-10. Begin with the Sign of the Cross. Read the prayer together and help your child with the actions.
- Follow the prayer described as outlined on R-11. Ask the children to share their answers to the question: *How can you follow Jesus?*
- Read and explain the symbols of baptism as outlined on R-12. When finished, make a welcome poster for those being baptized in our parish.
- Read and discuss the “bracelet of beads” described on R-13. If possible make a bracelet with your child and for the other members of your family. Let the bracelet remind you of your baptism and your call to follow Jesus each day.
- Close your time together by praying the prayer on R-14.
- **Parents...** Read “Bringing the Retreat Home” on R-15 and R-16. How might you be able to use some of this with your family?
- When you return to class, your Catechist will check all the exercises on R-9 to R-12.
