### **February 4, 2018**

#### ***Onsite Lesson at OMC: Chapter 17, pages 147-154***

- Begin the lesson with prayer, using the one found on page 147.
- Discuss: What are some things you get ready for? How do you prepare?
- Read and discuss pages 148 to 151. Complete all exercises, fill-ins, and/or drawings/poems that are on these pages. (Note: Parents, please be sure your child knows and can identify the meaning of the key words that are in **RED PRINT** on these pages.)
- Project Disciples, pages 152 and 153. Complete all exercises on these two pages.
- Complete the Chapter Test on page 154 to review all that you have learned!
- *If you were absent today...* When you return to class, your Catechist will check all the exercises you have completed on pages 148-151 and will check/review the completed work on pages 152-154.

### **February 5 - 17, 2018**

#### ***Home-based Lesson: Chapter 18, pages 155-162***

#### ***Please complete lesson and return completed work to class for next onsite lesson at OMC.***

- Gather with your child and other family members and begin your time together with a prayer of your own or with the one found on page 155.
- Discuss: Think about an important choice you had to make. What did you think about before choosing? How did you know whether you made the right choice?
- Read and discuss pages 156 to 159. Complete all exercises, fill-ins, and/or drawings/poems that are on these pages. (Note: Parents, please be sure your child knows and can identify the meaning of the key words that are in **RED PRINT** on these pages.)
- Project Disciples, page 160 and 161. Complete all exercises on these two pages.
- Complete the Chapter Test on page 162 to review all that you have learned!
- When you return to class, your Catechist will check all the exercises you have completed on pages 156-159 and will check/review the completed work on pages 160-162.

### **February 18, 2018**

#### ***Onsite Lesson at OMC: Celebrating Catholic Identity ~ Repentance (R 17 - 22)***

- Read R-17 (follows pg. 184). Briefly review with the children what they know about sin and forgiveness. Read through the page and have children describe the scene. Complete the activity.
- Use the prayer on R-18. Begin with the Sign of the Cross. Ask the children to complete the prayer as indicated. Have students share their responses. End with the Act of Contrition.
- Follow the prayer described as outlined on R-19. Ask the children to share their answers to the question: *When do you feel God's mercy and forgiveness?*

- Read the text outlined on R-20. When finished, give the children pre-cut crosses. Invite them to write on each cross one thing they will do in each of the following areas: *prayer, penance, and acts of love and mercy.*
- Close your time together by praying the prayer on R-22.
- **Parents...** Read “Bringing the Retreat Home” on R-23 and R-24. How might you be able to use some of this with your family?
- ***If you were absent today...*** When you return to class, your Catechist will check all the exercises on R-17 to R-20.

## **February 19 – March 3, 2018**

***Home-based Lesson: Chapter 19, pages 163-170***

- Gather with your child and other family members to pray the prayer on page 163.
- Discuss: Think of a time when you felt hurt or sick. Who helped you? How did you feel after they helped you?
- Read and discuss pages 164 to 167. Complete all exercises, fill-ins, and/or drawings/poems that are on these pages. (Note: Parents, please be sure your child knows and can identify the meaning of the key words that are in **RED PRINT** on these pages.)
- Project Disciples, pages 168 and 169. Complete all exercises on these two pages.
- Complete the Chapter Test on page 170 to review all that you have learned!
