#### ***Home-based Lesson: Celebrating Catholic Identity ~ Sacraments of Healing (R 9 - 16)***

- Read R-9 (follows pg. 128). Read the page and complete the activity.
- Use the prayer on R-10. Begin with the Sign of the Cross. Read the prayer together and help your child name people or groups of people who need healing.

- Follow the prayer described as outlined on R-11. Ask the children to share their answers to the question: *How can I help others to experience Jesus' healing power?*
- Read the text outlined on R-12. With your child, dramatize one of the Scripture stories identified. Discuss the feelings of those involved in the story. Complete the activity to make a card as outlined in the last paragraph of the page.
- Read and complete with your child the activity as described on R-13.
- Close your time together by praying the prayer on R-14.
- **Parents...** Read "Bringing the Retreat Home" on R-15 and R-16. How might you be able to use some of this with your family?
