### **February 4, 2018**

# **February 18, 2018**

Onsite Lesson at OMC: Celebrating Catholic Identity ~ Human Dignity (R 17 - 22)

- Read R-17 (follows pg. 184). Explain that the picture on the page shows overlapping images of the same hand in various colors. It is a reminder that all people are created in the image and likeness of God but that each person is also unique and special. Complete the activity as described.
- Use the prayer on R-18. Remind students of what they learned regarding social sin in Chapter 15. Begin with the Sign of the Cross. Have students raise their hands to be called on to give their examples of social sin. Allow students time to write their messages and then to share.
- Follow the prayer described as outlined on R-19. Ask the children to share their answers to the question: *How would the world be different if everyone truly lived as God's image?*

- Read the intro as outlined on R-20. Tell students they have a "quest" ~ to hunt through Unit 3 of their book to find words that describe attitudes, behaviors, or ways through which Catholics can uphold human dignity. Write the words found. Then create a labyrinth sign as directed.
- Close your time together by praying the prayer on R-22.
- Parents... Read "Bringing the Retreat Home" on R-23 and R-24. How might you be able to use some of this with your family?
- *If you were absent today*... When you return to class, your Catechist will check all the exercises on R-17 to R-20.
