

## YEAR 5 – September, 2017

### September 17, 2017

*Parent Meeting followed by time in Child's PREP Classroom*

*Onsite Lesson at OMC: Celebrating Catholic Identity ~ Creed (R 1 - 8)*

- Read R-1 (follows pg. 16). Read the text and complete the activity. Ask the children to share their “blogs”. Reinforce what we believe regarding the Blessed Trinity ~ Father, Son, and Spirit.
- Use the prayer on R-2. Before you begin, explain to the students the three prayer postures that will be used during the prayer. Begin with the Sign of the Cross, our prayer to the Blessed Trinity. Allow time for the students to write their descriptions and then to share them.
- Follow the prayer described as outlined on R-3. Ask the children to share their answers to the question: *In this reading what are you, as a believer in the Blessed Trinity, asked to do? How will you do that?*
- Read and explain the activity as outlined on R-4. Share your podcast design. Remind the students that Jesus is counting on all of us to make disciples of all nations. We are called to teach others about God!
- Class Activity with Parents and children during the last 30 minutes of PREP class.
- Close your time together by praying the prayer on R-6.
- **Parents...** Read “Bringing the Retreat Home” on R-7 and R-8. How might you be able to use some of this with your family?
- *If you were absent today...* When you return to class, your Catechist will check all the exercises on R-1 to R-4.
